CADD[®]-Solis VIP Ambulatory Infusion Pump Training Course

Content Description:

The Smiths Medical CADD[®]-Solis VIP ambulatory infusion pump provides measured drug therapy to patients in the hospital or outpatient setting using one of the five delivery modes: PCA (patient controlled analgesia), continuous delivery, intermittent delivery, step delivery and taper delivery. The CADD[®]-Solis administrator medication safety software is used to customize the pump settings and provide safety around the therapy delivery settings.

This 2.0 hour course describes and demonstrates proper use of CADD[®]-Solis VIP ambulatory infusion pump using sample protocol library settings. The course includes a self-paced video module with an interactive skills test and several reference documents. Participants are provided with step-by-step instructions on pump programming, alerts and alarms, and pump operations.

This online course is just one component of training. Pump users should also participate in “hands on” training with a CADD[®]-Solis VIP ambulatory infusion pump facilitated by an instructor who is skilled in the use of this device. Proper technique should be verified using a Skills Checklist. Pump users must follow their facility’s practice guidelines/policies and procedures on the use of infusion devices. Product use should always follow the manufacturer’s instructions for use detailed in the Operation Manual.

Objectives:

After completing the CADD[®]-Solis VIP ambulatory infusion pump training course the participant will be able to:

- Identify the indications for use for the CADD[®]-Solis VIP ambulatory infusion pump
- Demonstrate proper use and programming of the CADD[®]-Solis VIP ambulatory infusion pump in each of the 5 delivery modes
- Describe proper response to the CADD[®]-Solis VIP ambulatory infusion pump alerts and alarms
